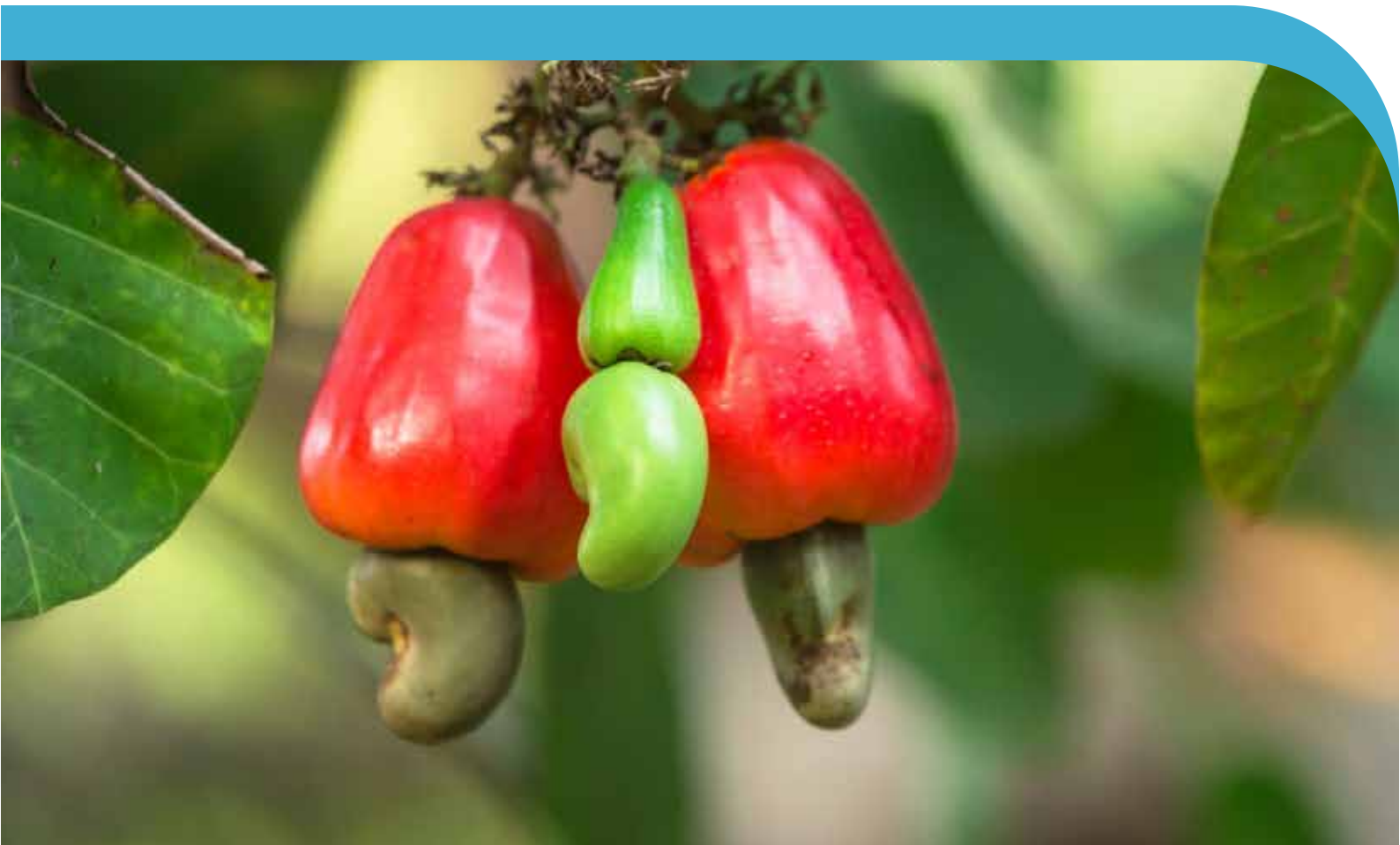

Cashew in Africa

Cashew's role as an essential ingredient in many cuisines and its rising popularity as a nutritious snack have led to soaring demand in the Asia-Pacific, Europe and the Americas.

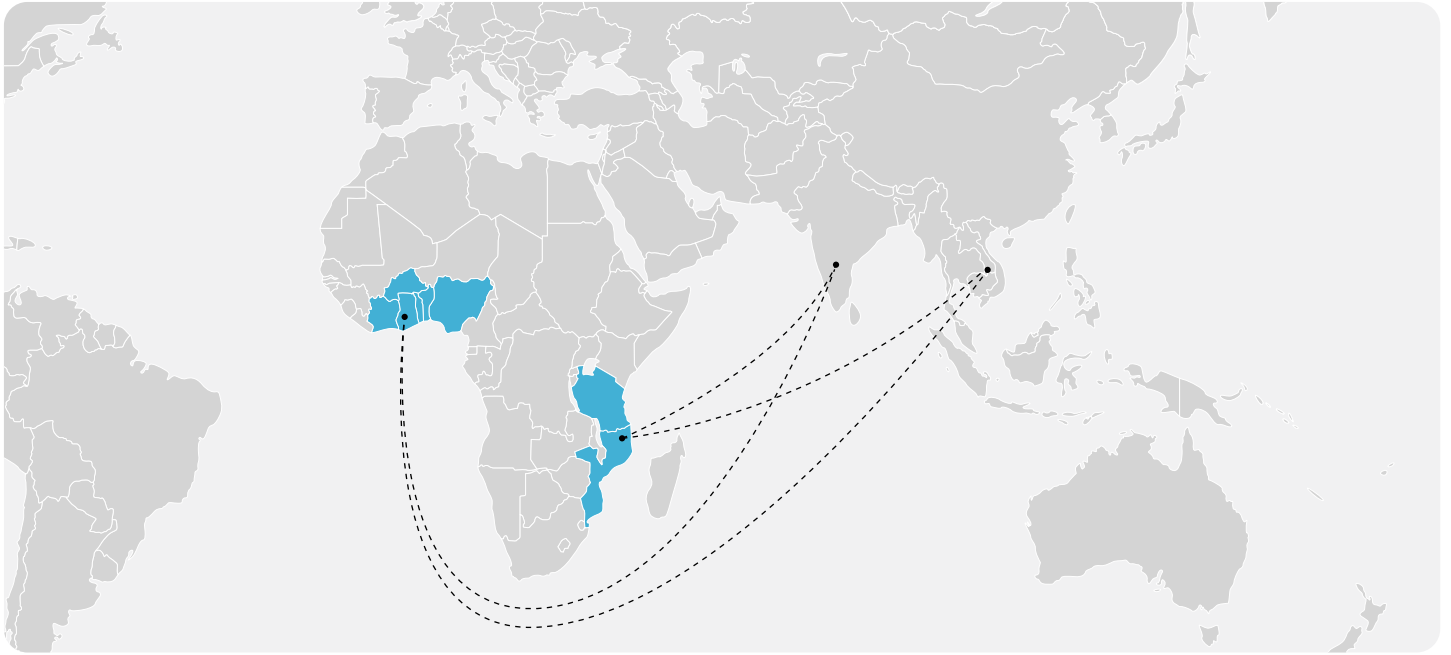
Outside Asia, Africa is home to the biggest cashew producers in the world. About 90% of the raw cashew nuts (RCNs) traded in the global market are produced in just 20 African countries.

Driven by rising consumption, world trade in RCNs doubled between 2000 and 2018, and African producers led by Ivory Coast accounted for nearly two-thirds of the growth.

However, it is in Asia – especially in India and Vietnam – that the cashews from Africa are deshelled and processed to give them more value. India and Vietnam together imported 98% of the world's raw cashew imports between 2014 and 2018.

However, in recent years, countries like Ivory Coast, Nigeria and Mozambique, among others have started processing cashews in their countries while others are working to increase their processing capacity, affording local farmers the opportunity to diversify income sources.

Raw Cashew Nuts Flow

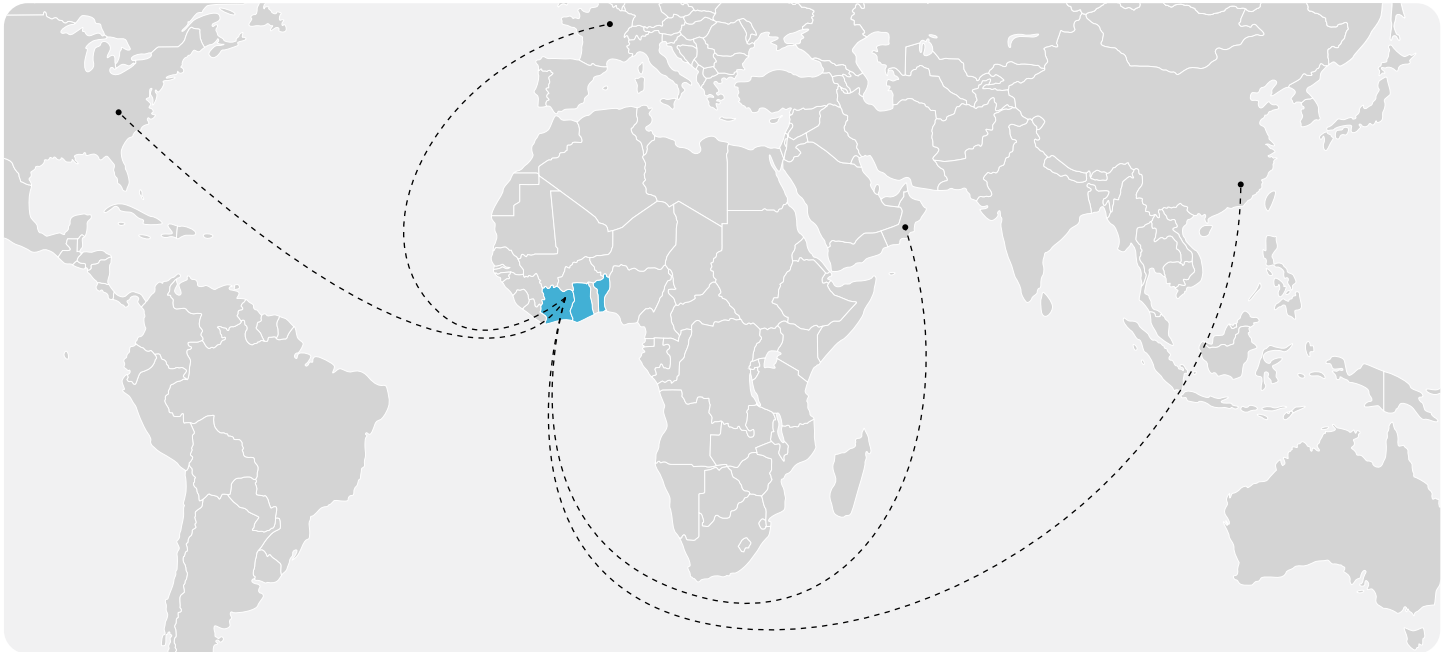

Cashew Kernel Flow

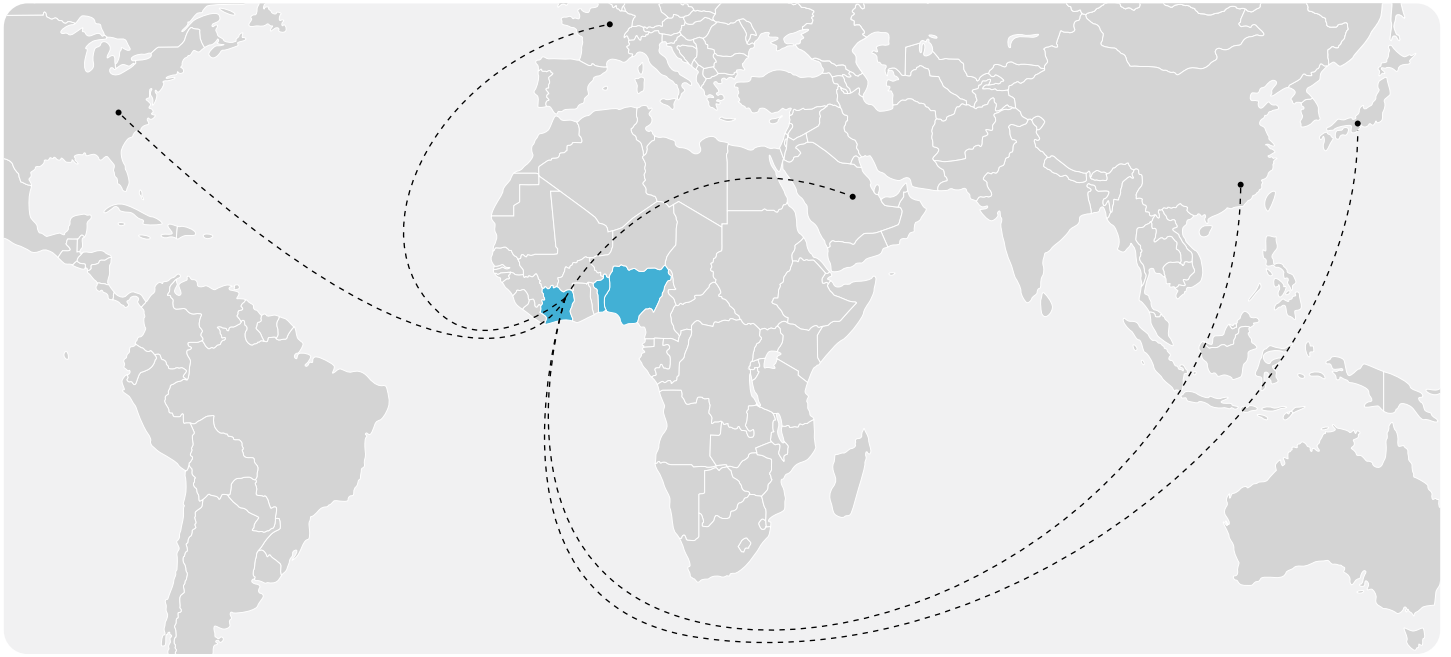

CNSL (Cashew Shell Nut Liquid) Flow

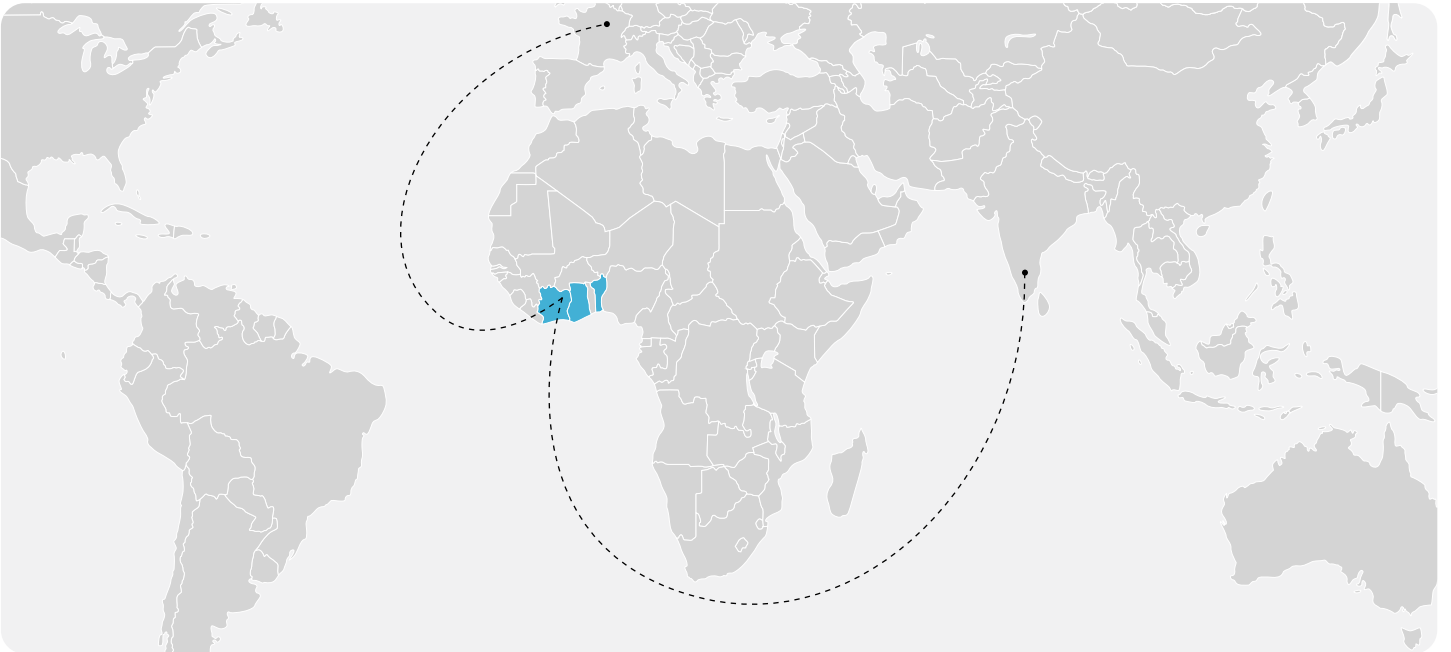

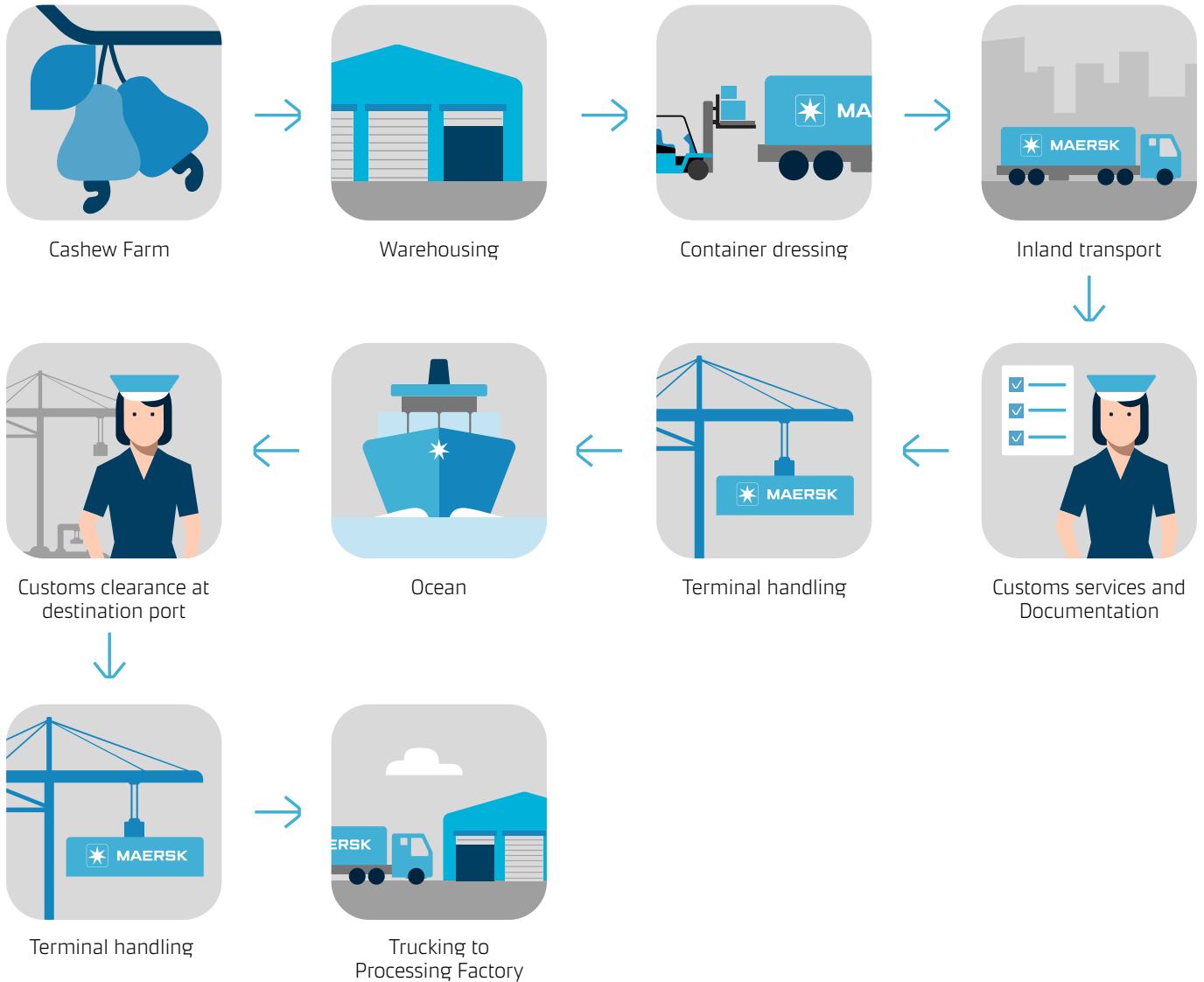

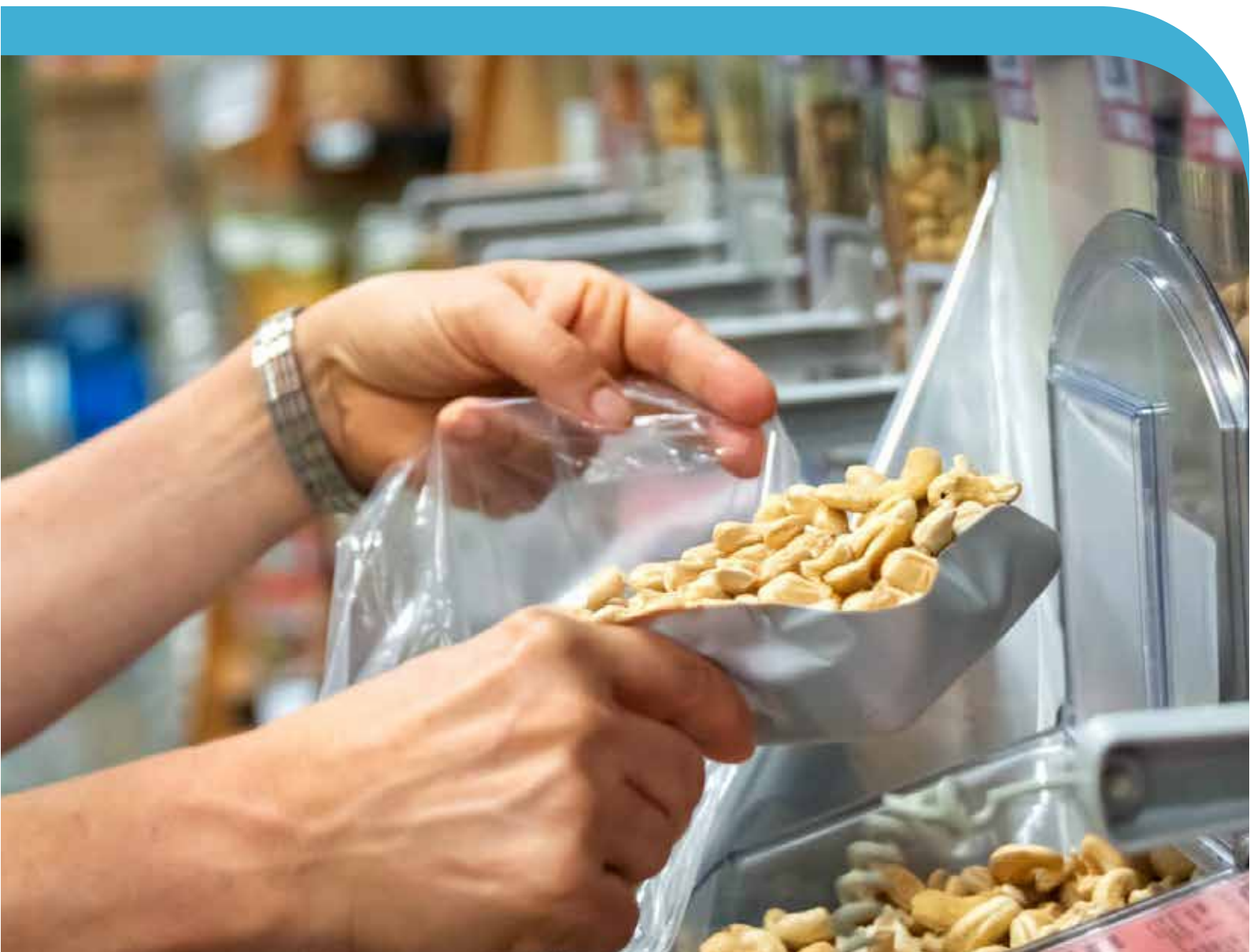
